## **APPLICATION:**

First Appearance MG Fuel 3 Orangeburg Rd/Appeal to Zoning Officer Decision

Attorney Mr. Gary Giannantonio of Hackensack introduces himself and is representing MG Fuel, owner of the gas station at 3 Orangeburg Road. He begins to explain the application he is making for opening a convenience store in the waiting area of the gas station. Mr. Giannantonio is representing that it is proposed to be a low intensity/small retail use in a currently approved non-conforming.

Mr. Regan interrupts Mr. Giannantonios' presentation to clarify that this hearing is for the application submitted, which is for the appeal, in either reversal or upholding, of the zoning officer decision. Mr. Giannantonio presents that he plans to get approval for non conforming use, and he has brought a planner (he would like to have her explain the use intended, etc). Mr Regan explains that the testimony cannot be heard due to the fact that a variance application or site plan review application has not been filed, merely an an appeal to a decision made by the zoning officer.

Board Planner Mr. Szabo is sworn in and confirms either a D1 or a D2 application should have been filed, and all that is before the board currently, is the appeal of the zoning officer's denial.

Additionally, Mr. Skrable, borough engineer's email is read by Mr Regan stating the need for a full site plan, landscaping, parking and environmental cleanup info to proceed.

Mr Giannantonio consults with his planner and client and have decided to do submit another application for the D variance and site plan review. Mr. Regan confirms that new notices/publication etc must be done as well and the entire application process must start over from the beginning.
