# Right of Way / Road Opening or Street Excavation

This Permit is required by the Borough of Old Tappan for excavation within the Street or Right-of-Way along all Municipal Roads throughout the Borough.

A Right of Way (ROW) Permit is required for work to be performed within the Borough's ROW or easement. The Borough's ROW generally extends 10' beyond the edge of the roadway.

A Road Opening or Street Excavation permit is required for any person/contractor/utility requiring removal of, dig into, disturb, excavate, take up or procure to be removed, disturb, excavate, or dig up the surface of any public street, lane, alley, court in the Borough.

Examples of work that require a Permit are as follows:

### **RESIDENTIAL / COMMERCIAL IMPROVEMENTS:**

- Driveway
- Sidewalk
- Drainage (sump pump discharges, roof leaders, drywell overflows, etc.)
- Connections to existing Borough storm sewer system

#### **UTILITY WORK:**

- Sanitary sewer
- Water lines (distribution & private)
- Natural gas lines
- Electric lines
- Communication lines (phone, cable, fiber-optic, etc.)
- Structures (utility poles, fire hydrants, utility cabinets, manholes, vaults, etc.)

#### **ROADWORK:**

- Curbing
- · Asphalt repairs
- Storm water drainage systems

#### MISCELLANEOUS:

- Sign installations
- Test pits
- \* Soil borings

Permit application MUST include a 24-hour emergency contact number.

## **Inspections**

Inspections are performed to ensure the work is completed in accordance with the required specifications, proper compaction is completed, and safe conditions exist for the motoring public. For any opening in the pavement a bond is held for a period of two years to ensure the repair does not settle. After two years a final inspection is performed and if the repair is satisfactory the bond will be released.

#### **Tracking**

The permitting process allows us to track who completed the work at each location and if there is a problem, we can have the ability to contact the contractor responsible for the work to complete the necessary repairs
