Bills are mailed once a year. Taxes are due **February 1, May 1, August 1, and November 1**. The Borough allows for a grace period of 10 days after the property tax deadline without interest or penalty.

SEWER USER FEE:

Bills are mailed at the beginning of the year. Payment can be made in full or in two payments which are due **April 1 and October 1**. The Borough allows for a 10-day grace period.
